**Hunter Pleasure**—Judged as a pleasure class. Will divide into Pony and Horse Sections if entries warrant.

**SWVHJA Beginner Equitation:** Open to junior and amateur riders in their first year of showing. Fences 2'. No oxers permitted. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence heights exceeding 2'. This division not to count against rider's eligibility for the Intermediate Division. To be judged on rider's position and control.

**Intermediate Hunter:** Open to anyone in his/her first or second year of showing, on horses or ponies excluding the Beginner Equitation Division. Fences 2'3". Once a rider shows over fences 2'6" or higher, they are no longer eligible for the Intermediate Hunter division in subsequent years. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Rider may not jump fences higher than 2'6" at the same show.

**Small/Medium Pony Hunter:** Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same show. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Small ponies (not to exceed 12.2 h.) to jump 2', medium ponies (over 12.2 h.—not to exceed 13.2 h.) to jump 2'3". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

**Large Pony Hunter:** Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners and way of going. Large ponies (over 13.2 h.—not to exceed 14.2 h.) to jump 2'6". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

**SWVHJA Pony Medal Class:** Open to junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. Class to consist of 2 phases judged 50% for each. The same pony must be used for both phases of this class. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. A minimum of 6 riders, if available, must be called back to work on the flat. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. 4 entries are required to fill this class. A rider cannot compete in both the Junior Medal and the Pony Medal at the same show.

**Special Children's Hunter:** Open to junior riders mounted on horses or ponies. Fences to be 2' 6" or 2' 9". Both heights must be offered and judged together. Related distances between two jumps should be no less than 60' (4 strides). Judges on performance, manners and way of going. Horse/rider combination cannot compete over fences higher than 2' 9" at the same show. The Special Adult Division and the Special Children's Division may be combined if there are fewer than 3 entries in either division.

**Special Adult Hunter:** Same specs as Special Children's Hunter. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show.

### NOTES:

1. Judge's decision is final
2. All horses/ponies must present a current Coggins.
3. Entry fee \$12.00 per class. 6 ribbons will be offered in each class. Champion and Reserve awarded in all Divisions.
4. Controlled schooling allowed from 6:30 to 8:15 a.m. Also 10 minute schooling prior to Hopeful Hunter Division.
5. Pre-entries (prior to July 20) given a three dollar credit.
6. Food will be available on grounds.
7. Sales class open to horses/ponies offered for sale.
